President Allen called the meeting to order at 10:00am, declared a quorum, and thanked those present for attending.

Allen introduced Bob Vogt who will by taking over the scheduling duties which had been under the care of Ned Hedges.

Augestine presented information regarding No-Shows at Fun Days. While this number decreased considerably in 2019 from 2018 there were still 13 instances in 2019. This lack of attendance creates a huge burden on the managers at the last minute to rearrange teams, score cards and individuals. The Board voted to amend the league rules to state that if a cancellation occurs less than 24 hours prior to tee time, said cancellation will be treated like a complete No-Show. Emergency situations will be considered on an individual basis. President Allen will attempt to write this into the League rules and inform members in a mass email.

The number of players in the 18 hole divisions will be limited to 288. (18 divisions with 8 2man teams). While the board feels that this number is not in jeopardy in the near future, it could happen soon. There remains the option of increasing the minimum age to 60.

Considerable discussion was held regarding the 9 hole divisions. Under consideration is moving them to a fourth course for their play and Fairway (previously known as The Links) seems to be a popular suggestion. Board members were encouraged to visit with 9-holers they know to learn of their feelings.

Multiple discussions followed but none requiring board action and meeting adjourned at 11:15.
